TIME OUT Caring for the CAREGIVER

Caregivers

Most people become caregivers at one point in their lives. That care may take an emotional, physical, and financial toll on caregiver families.

Caregivers need someone to stay with their loved ones while they have some personal time away from home- a chance to spend time with friends and family, time to run errands or other activities.

Time out volunteers are companions visiting with the loved one to ensure they are safe while the caregiver is away. Activities may include sitting with person, reading, and conversing. Volunteers are not required to provide physical care.

If you enjoy helping people in need and have some free time, consider becoming a time out volunteer. Covenant Church becomes the body of Christ in the way we care for one another

Caregivers experience certain challenges, frustrations, and blessings that may be best known, and most freely communicated, to those in a similar situation. A group of Covenant caregivers meets monthly for fellowship and mutual support.

TRANSPORTATION MINISTRY



Volunteers provide transportation to members who are unable to drive. Rides are provided, for example, to medical appointments and church services.





