

GOD HEEDS OUR CALL is the theme for our THANK OFFERING LUNCHEON. This will begin our 2019-2020 term. We'll have

wonderful fellowship time, installation of our new officers, hear information concerning our THANK OFFERING and have an introduction of our new study book, which will be available for \$10.00.

The THANK OFFERING originated in the late 1800s by Presbyterian Women of North America. Mary Ann Stripling will give an overview of our offering which includes eighteen recipients chosen for funding. Twelve of the projects serve people in the USA and six are international. More than 40 percent of the selected projects are related to health ministries; 60 percent is used for such needs as elder care and literacy.

Rev. Sarah Wolf will introduce our new study, LOVE CARVED IN STONE: A Fresh Look at the Ten Commandments by Eugenia Anne Gamble, and present Lesson 1, "I Am Your God; You Shall Have No Others." Primary scripture is from Exodus 20:2-6 and Matthew 22:34-37.



For those **new** to using Instant Church Directory, there are several ways to access the directory:

- Online via the Instant Church Directory website:
 - 1. Go to members.InstantChurchDirectory.com
 - 2. Click on the "create login" button under: First time signing in?
 - 3. Enter your email address as it is listed in the directory.
 - 4. Create a password. The password must be 8 characters long and contain at least two of the following special characters: capital letters, numbers or symbols.
 - 5. Retype the password to confirm it and click "Request Login."
 - 6. Check your email inbox for an email from Instant Church Directory.
 - 7. To complete the sign-up process, you will need to verify your email address by clicking on the link sent to you in that email.
 - 8. Once you confirm your email, you may sign into Instant Church Directory. Your sign-in information will work on all the Instant Church Directory apps on any device.
- iPhone, iPad and any IOS Device Mobil App Instructions:
 - 1. Download the app from the App Store. Search for "Instant Church Directory" and look for the icon above.
 - 2. Open the app and click on the "create login" button.
 - 3. Follow steps 3 through 8 as above.
- Android and Kindle Device Mobil App Instructions:
 - 1. Download the app from the App Store. Search for "Instant Church Directory" and look for the icon above.
 - 2. Open the app and click on the "create login" button.
 - 3. Follow steps 3 through 8 as above.

If you have been able to access the directory previously, but forgot your personal member password, click on the **Forgot Password?** link to receive a link to your email to reset your password. Please know that passwords are private and not known by any of the church staff.
